**Please find below a statement from the English Bridge Union, notifying the EBL of the suspension of one player within their jurisdiction. The term of suspension will end on 22nd November 2020.**

**Each NBO is asked to recognise this action in accordance with Article C. 3 (b) of the By-laws of the EBL (reproduced below for your convenience)**

*Each NBO within the EBL must accept and respect all decisions taken by the EBL and other NBOs in disciplinary matters. In particular, all NBOs within the EBL shall recognize the EBL's and each other's suspensions and expulsions, without examining the reason therefore.*

*Dear President,*

*At a recent Disciplinary Hearing of the English Bridge Union, Mr LEIV BORNECRANTZ (EBU – 484530) was found guilty of three charges relating to behaviour at an EBU tournament... The Disciplinary Committee imposed a sanction of a fine and two years' suspension of membership of the English Bridge Union. Subject to payment of the fine, the suspension will end on 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2020.*
